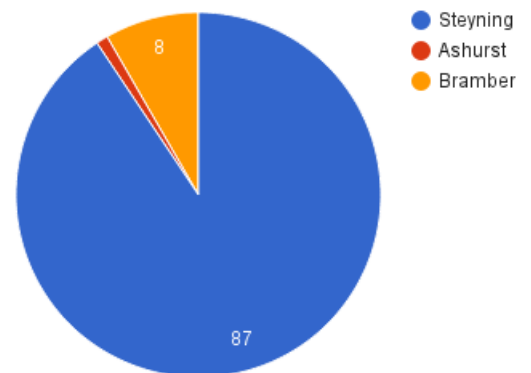

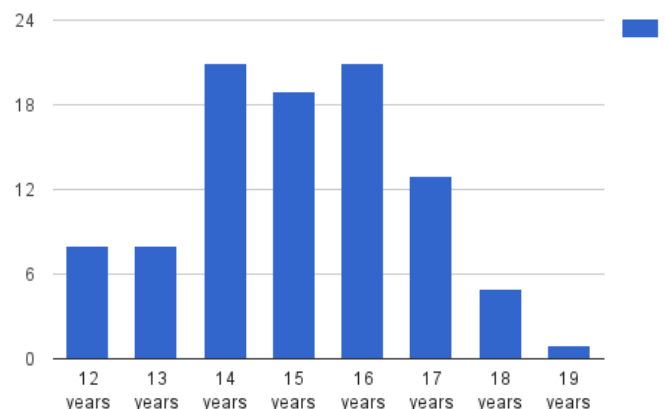

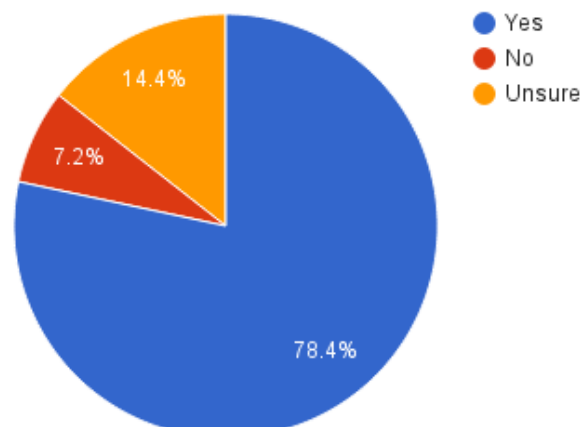

The majority of comments (29) mentioned the location and closeness of Steyning Medical Centre to them.

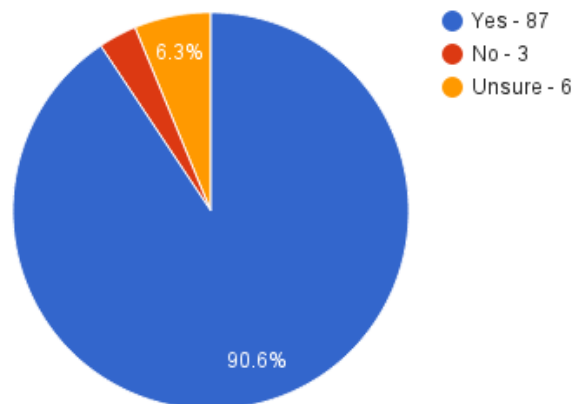
Other comments included, relationships with staff, feeling able to have confidential and accessible appointments.

Comments (See appendix 1b for full answers)

There were 33 comments from those who answered YES - Many of these comments focused on Steyning leisure Centre and mentioned quality, locality and the services on offer.

There were 4 comments from those who answered NO – these included comments on topics such as price, quality and availability.

There were 3 comments from those who answered UNSURE - these included comments regarding lack of facilities and opportunities for young people to use facilities.

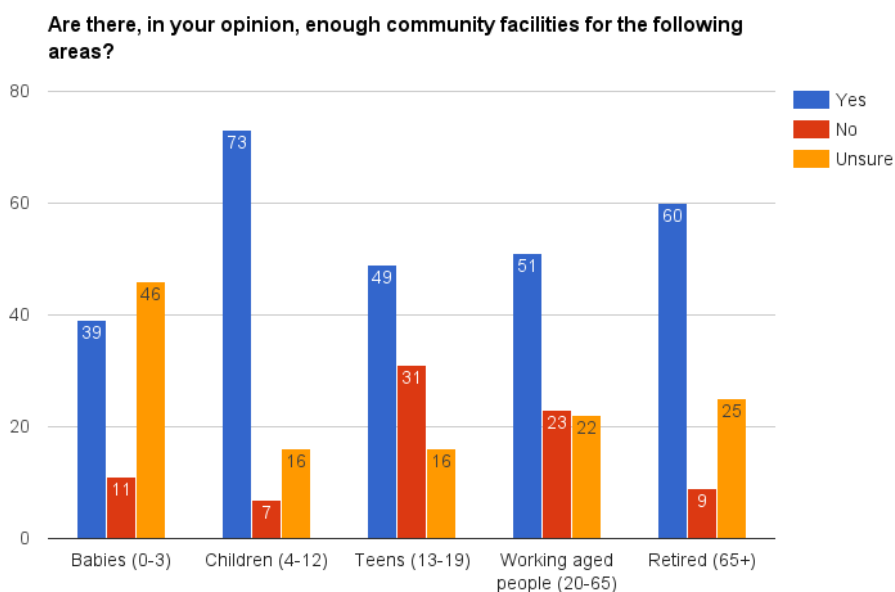

There were 46 comments received. Many of these responses referred to services for teenagers and included requests for places to congregate, facilities such as shops, parks and food outlets/chain coffee shops.

There were a small number of responses that mentioned the need for more entertainment for teenagers such as cinemas, camping ground and a bowling complex as well as clothing stores and a larger supermarket. 7 comments mentioned a skate park. 5 comments mentioned shops or a Shopping Centre. The young people mentioned that they would like to see more clubs and facilities for both babies and the elderly during the daytime.

There were 46 comments received.

The majority of comments (12) sited the cricket field/memorial playing field as a suitable location, 5 comments mentioned the center of town/the high street, 4 comments spoke about fletchers croft/The Steyning Centre, 3 comments mentioned a the leisure Centre or school with 2 comments in favor of the downs. The Penfold hall and Old cement works were also suggested as suitable locations. Included was a comment re: not being in favor of a skate park in Steyning.

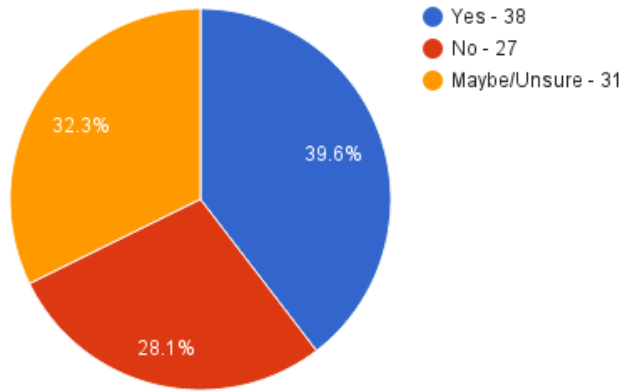

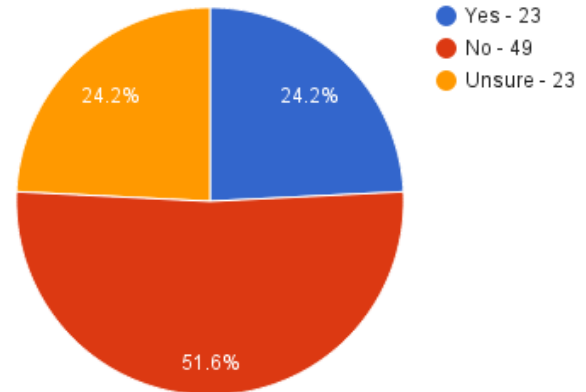
Do you think it would be financially possible to live in this community as a young adult?

Do you think it would be financially possible to live in this community as a young adult?

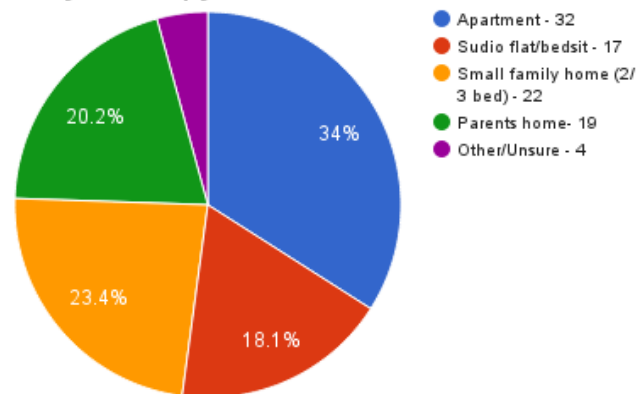

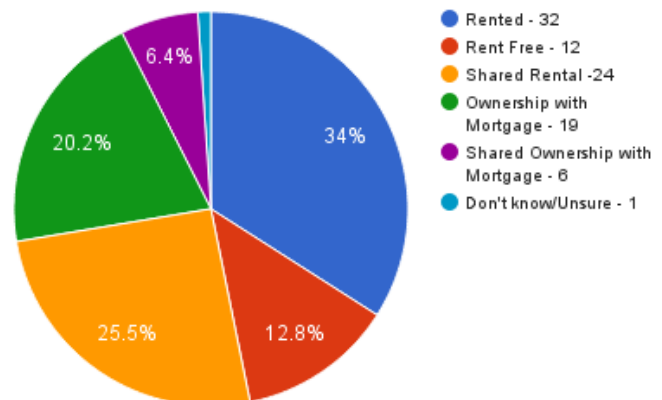
If you were to live in this community as a young adult what sort of housing would you be most likely to occupy?

On what basis would you expect to occupy your home?

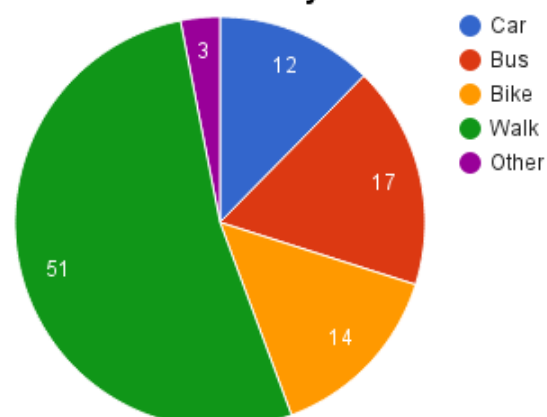

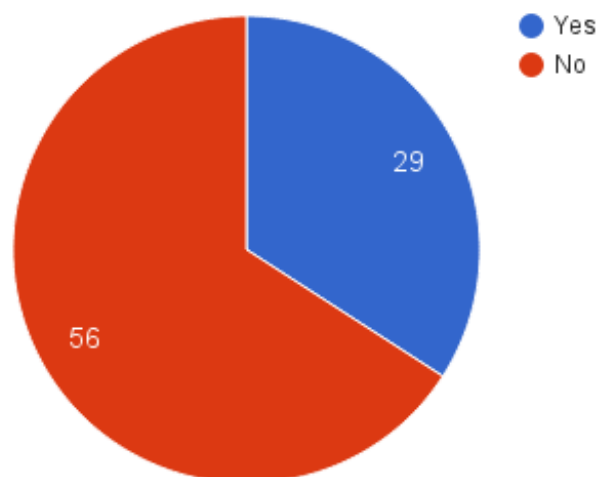

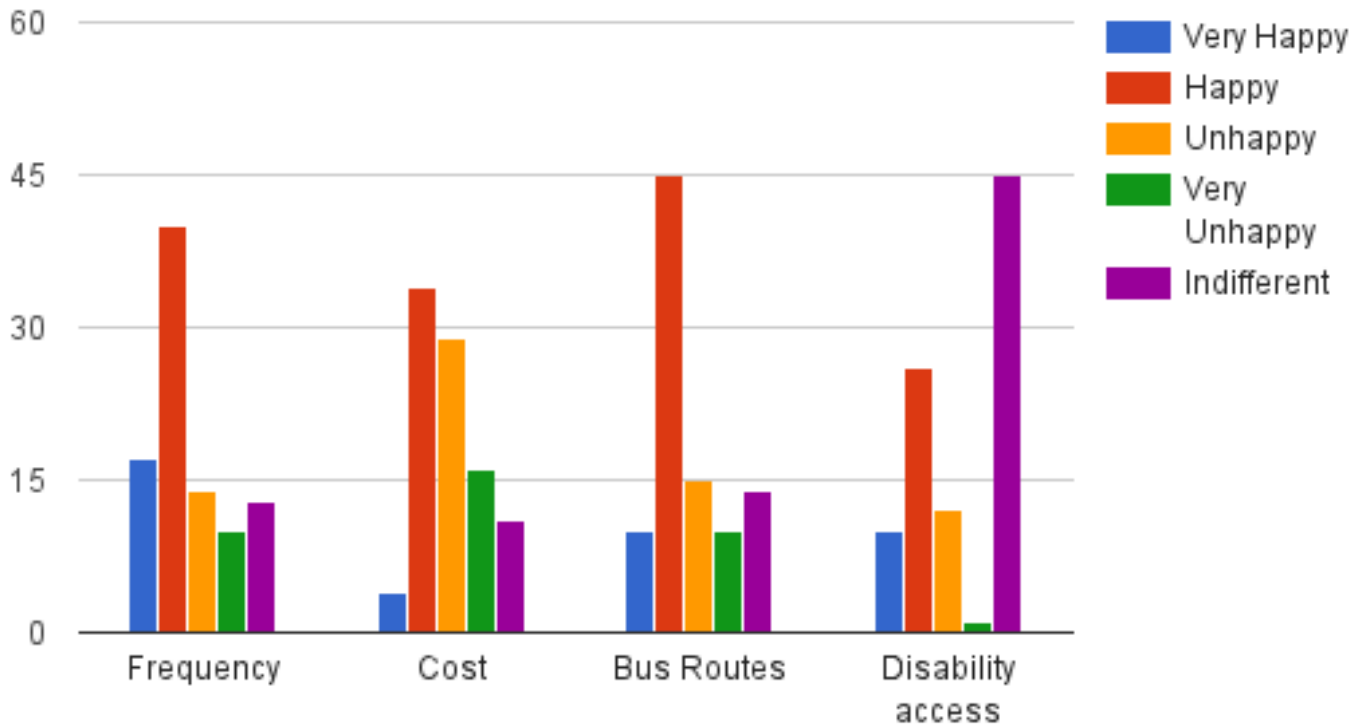

22 comments were received – 7 comments mentioned dissatisfaction about the price of bus services, 6 stated dissatisfaction with the bus journey to Brighton the length of journey time was mentioned several times. 4 commented that the bus service was unreliable and that sometimes busses were late or didn't show up. 3 mentioned issue with the bus routes, 2 stating there wasn't a direct bus to Partridge Green and one stating no direct to Worthing.

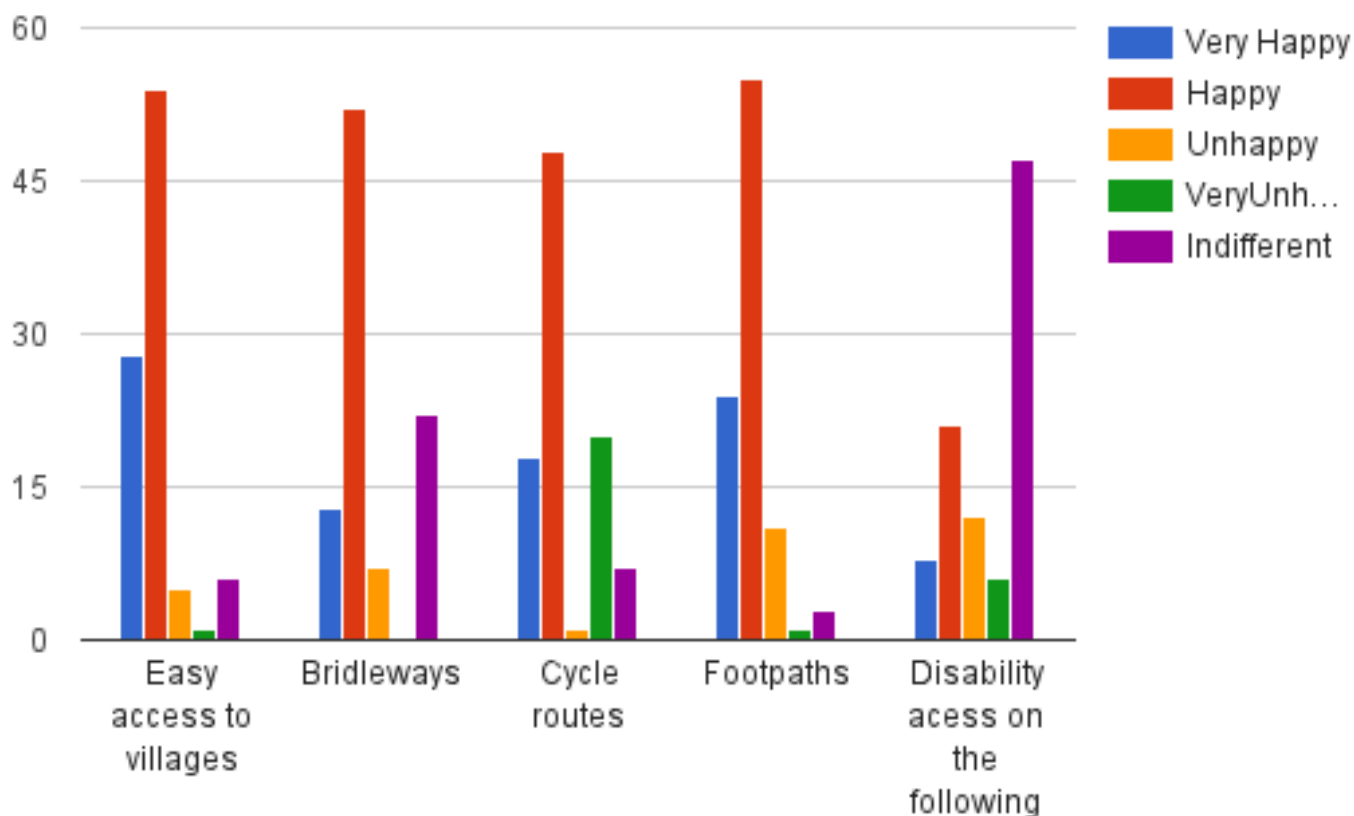

This may not seem like a lot, but using the bus on a regular bases means the cost adds up, and forces people my age to either travel out of Steyning less, or find other means of transport. This is why i applied for a bus card, so i can avoid this hassle. However, a lot of my friends and others my age are completely unaware that a bus card is even an option, or how to apply. The only reason i found out about it was because my Mum was told by someone else.”</p>
