

Minutes of the Wivelsfield Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group Meeting

1. **Apologies for Absence**

2. **Minutes of the Steering Group Meeting Held 28 August 2014**

Subject to these amendments, the Steering Group approved the content of the report and agreed that it would be put forward to the Parish Council for consideration as a part of the evidence base for the Pre-Submission Draft of the Neighbourhood Plan.

The Chairman asked for it to be minuted that letters had been received (and distributed to all members of the Council) from a member of the public and from David Maher representing Coldharbour Farm.
